
Global Learning & Cultural Exposure




Ueno Park

Tokyo Skytree




The day concludes with a visit to Tokyo Skytree. Participants are able to take a closer look of the tower. participants are allowed to freely take photos.

How to Apply

- 1 Choose the program to follow.
- Fill out the registration form on the website https://studentexchange.id
- Get a Registration Confirmation Email, and wait for data verification a maximum of 3 x 24 hours.
- Get a Letter of Acceptance (LoA) sent to the registration email.
- 5 Make payments and confirm payments via Email or WA.
- Congratulations on being part of the "List of Participants Student Exchange ID"
- **7** Grouping and Departure Preparation.
- 8 Program Departure.

Requirements

1. Participant Eligibility

- Indonesian citizens (Students SMA/SMK, Gap Year, University level, or Professional).
- Minimum age 15 years old.
- Physically and mentally fit to travel internationally.
- Able to follow all program rules and schedules.

2. Required Documents

- Valid Passport : Must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of departure.
- ID Card/Student Card : School or university student ID is acceptable.
- Parental Consent Letter : Required for participants under 15 years old.
- Program Application Form : Completed via the official registration link.
- Proof of Payment : Invoice and payment receipt confirmation.
